



Manifolds - Part 38

Integration: $f: \mathbb{R} \longrightarrow \mathbb{R}$ (smooth function later)



See f(x) as a density at point $x \in \mathbb{R}$:



$$\sum_{\mathbf{R}} f(\mathbf{x}) \cdot \Delta \mathbf{x} \sim \int_{\mathbf{R}} f(\mathbf{x}) \, d\mathbf{x} = \text{total mass}$$

Let's take
$$M = \mathbb{R}^2$$
: differential form $\omega: p \mapsto f(p) \, dx \, dy \in Alt^2(T_pM)$

$$\longrightarrow \omega_p(v,w) = f(p) \left(\underbrace{dx(v) \cdot dy(w)}_{V_1} - \underbrace{dx(w) \cdot dy(v)}_{V_2} \right)$$

$$= f(p) \, \det(v,w)$$

integral:
$$\int_{M} \omega := \int_{M} \int_{M} dx \wedge dy = \int_{\mathbb{R}^{2}} \int_{\mathbb{R}^{2}} (x,y) d(x,y)$$
